

About the Artwork

'The Big Round' is 7 metres wide and 7 metres tall.

'The Tall Long' is 9 metres tall.


'The Big Round', a singular expressive geometry, is stripped away from all extravagance of form and details.

'The Tall Long' is buoyant and stretches upwards.

Through their sheer size and proportion, 'The Big Round & The Tall Long' engages the commuters by inviting them to either step away in order to view it, or to simply be drawn in to a presence that is larger than the self.

This approach was to introduce a sense of scale through an immersive artwork that helps the commuters relate to this big and spacious station.

By drawing a parallel relationship between the artwork and the sitting area, the artwork suggests an emotive reference between a person, and people around him, his objects and his space within the station's environment.




About the Artist
