

Recent Enforcement Efforts

Over the past month, our #ActiveMobility enforcement officers (#AMEOs) conducted a series of operations against errant Active Mobility (AM) users at locations such as Bedok, Robinson Road, Sengkang, Tampines and Woodlands. We also conducted joint operations with the Singapore Police Force to enforce against large groups cycling on roads.

A total of 77 offences were detected during these operations, such as riding of non-compliant devices, using devices on the wrong paths, and keeping non-compliant power-assisted bicycles.

Over the past two weeks, our #ActiveMobility enforcement officers (#AMEOs) conducted a series of operations against errant active mobility users at various locations such as Boon Lay, Central Boulevard, Marine Parade, Punggol, Tanjong Rhu and Yishun.

A total of 30 offences were detected during these operations. These included the use of non-compliant devices (Personal Mobility Devices and Power-Assisted Bicycles) and riding of devices on wrong paths.

To ensure the safety of all path and road users, we will continue to enforce against errant active mobility users including those who use non-compliant devices. Non-compliant devices will be impounded immediately for safety reasons. #ProtectorOfPaths
